# Information for newcomers and their parents about school life at the GSD

#### **Lesson times**

Classes at the Dreiländereck Primary School begin at 7.40 am. Classes close at 12.15 pm after the 5th lesson and at 1 pm after the 6th lesson. Break times are from 9.10 am - 9.40 am and from 11.10 am - 11.30 am.

## Access to the school buildings

From 7.00 a.m. onwards, the schoolyard behind the building is available for the arriving children. As a rule, children can enter the school buildings and their respective class from 7.30 am. Depending on the weather and the time of year, this may be permitted earlier.

#### Access to the school grounds

The bus children reach the school grounds via the footpath which begins behind the gymnasium at the height of the Kreissparkasse on Hubertus-von-Nell-Straße and leads directly to the playground. Many pedestrians or children who are dropped off by their parents in the Saarburger Straße or HvN-Straße area also use this path.

Another access is from Kirschenstraße via the courtyard at the Old School, from where the schoolyard can also be reached. Parking is available at the municipal administration on Trierer Straße.

Please note that cars may only be driven onto the school grounds between 7.00 a.m. and 5.30 p.m. by school and FGTS staff, municipal employees and other authorised persons (e.g. pupils with physical disabilities).

In the interest of the safety of our school children, the car access road will not be used as a footpath during school hours.

If you would like to pick up your child after FGTS, please use parking facilities in the vicinity (e.g. Hubertus-von-Nell-Straße / car park municipal administration) and then come to school on foot. This is for the safety of your children and helps to defuse danger points and reduce conflicts. Leave the grounds with your child either past the Old School in the direction of the Town Hall or through the sports hall in the direction of the Sparkasse branch / Hubertus-von-Nell-Straße.

#### **Bus transport**

The departure and arrival times of the school buses in your area can be found in the Mosella or on the timetables on our notice boards in the entrance areas of the school and FGTS.

In the morning, a supervisor awaits the children at the bus stop and ensures that they walk to the schoolyard in an orderly manner. After the end of lessons, the children are led back to the bus stop by a teacher and supervised until the last bus has arrived and left. If necessary, the bus supervisor also settles ambiguities regarding the routes of the individual buses and ensures that the children are seated on the correct buses.

However, school transport is basically the responsibility of the school authority, i.e. the municipality of Perl. If you have any further questions, difficulties or complaints in connection with bus transport, please contact the person in charge directly:
